ROUTE 606 INTERCHANGE OPENS

Providing immediate relief to one of the most congested areas along Route 28, the interchange at Route 606, Old Ox Road, opened to traffic on October 9th, 2004. This initial opening completed 5 of the 8 ramps and the bridge over Route 28. Also, the western portion of the intersection detour was closed, thus allowing construction of the ramps in that area. The signal on Route 28 was removed and two more of these ramps opened to traffic on November 13th. The final loop ramp is scheduled to open by the end of the year.

Joining the Route 28 Corridor Improvements team for a ribbon-cutting ceremony on October 7th to mark the opening were members of the Virginia House of Delegates, the Loudoun County Board of Supervisors, Loudoun County officials, representatives of the Commonwealth Transportation Board, Virginia Department of Transportation officials, local business, and Route 28 Tax District property owners.

This interchange opening is the 2nd of the 6 interchanges included in the Route 28 PPTA project and comes at the halfway point in the Contract with VDOT. Completed under a design-build, PPTA contract, these project milestones highlight how quickly a major, complex highway project can be completed when design, right of way acquisition, permitting, utility relocations, and construction are performed concurrently.

INTERCHANGE UPDATE:

Air & Space Museum Parkway

This interchange opened to traffic in December 2003. Construction is underway on a portion of the replacement Sully Access Road. The balance of the road will be constructed in the Summer of 2005.

Route 625 (Waxpool/Church Roads)

Construction is progressing to open a majority of the interchange and remove the signal on Route 28 by the end of 2004. Construction of the first half of the flyover bridge is nearly complete. Waxpool Road Bridge over Broad Run is complete and work is progressing to widen Waxpool Road to 6 lanes. Construction is planned to begin on the Church Road Bridge over the W&OD Trail this winter.

Route 606 (Old Ox Road)

The Route 606 Bridge over Route 28 and 5 of the 8 ramps opened to traffic on October 9, 2004. Two more ramps opened and the last part of the Route 28 signal was removed on November 13th.

Westfields Boulevard

Construction is moving forward to open the signalized detour intersection by the end of the year. After opening, work can begin on the new bridge over Route 28. Work is progressing on the new ramps and loops in the northwest quadrant, sewer relocations, and earthwork.

McLearen Road

Plans are complete and nearing review approval.

Sterling Boulevard

Plans are underway and will be submitted for approval by the end of 2004.

Loudoun County Parkway

Plans are nearing completion. Utility relocations are scheduled to begin in the Winter of 2005.
